Welcome to JTMS:

Jefferson Township Middle School is a wonderful, fun, and exciting place to be. The sixth graders' experience is very different from what you are used to at the elementary schools. First, students from Stanlick and White Rock will be together and you will have an opportunity to meet new friends. Secondly, you will be given more freedom and independence that will help you become more responsible and self-efficient. Finally, you will be challenged with a rigorous curriculum that will prepare you for a successful future.

Teams:

The sixth grade is divided into three teams: Six Blue, Six Gold, and Six White. Each team has five teachers: Language Arts, Math, Science, Social Studies, and Special Education.

Middle School Terms

6th Grade Cut-Through – Outside path from C-Wing to B-Wing (6th graders ONLY). Exit between C1 and C12. Enter other doors. Upstairs leads to entrance/exit by B2 and B3 (Rooms B1-B20, Media Center, and Seminar Room) and down the stairs leads to entrance/exit by B28 and G Wing (Location of B21-B30 and G Wing Rooms).

Homeroom: Also considered "Flex Class"

Flex Class: 25-minute class either before or after lunch. Time is usually used for reading. Flex/Homeroom teacher will explain what is or is not permitted during "flex" within the first few days of school.

Agenda Book: Use it to write down homework assignments and use as a hall pass.

Late Bus: Leaves at 3:25 from after school activities, extra help or detention.

Blue Pass: A pass for your parents to pick you up at dismissal from Blue Pass Door.

White Pass: A pass for your parents to pick you up early from school in the Main Office.

Accelerated Reader (AR): A program where you read books, take a test, and earn points. Part of your language arts grade.

Wave 1: Dismissal for busses on Lake Hopactong side of town (HM01-HM16 and Vans- departs usually around 2:25).

Wave 2: Dismissal for busses on Milton Side of town (HM17-HM33-departs usually around 2:30).

High-Five: An award given to students who do something nice for someone else.

C-Wing and A-Wing: Areas of the building with 6th grade lockers.

PBSIS: Positive Behavior Supports in Schools. Students will be given a ticket when noticed doing exceptional things here at school.
